New Maryland Crane Safety Regulations

The Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation recently promulgated new regulations covering crane safety that expands the previous requirements for qualifications of operators, riggers, and signalpersons. The new regulations became effective in April. You can be cited now for violations if you don't take the appropriate steps to ensure that your team is properly trained and certificated. Even if you only use cranes occasionally, you need to be aware of these new standards and your obligations under them. Safety Directors should not miss this presentation.
